Sub:- Admissions in BHMS course with 60 seats for the year 2018-19 at Faculty of Homoeopathic Sciences, Jayoti Vidhyapeeth Woman University, Jaipur, Sir,

I am directed to refer the provisions prescribed under sub regulation 3(4) of HCC(MSR), 2013, wherein, the existing college has to fulfill the minimum standard requirement of infrastructure, teaching & training facilities by 31.12.2014 for consideration of grant of permission for undertaking admission in the coming academic year. Further, as per the provision of sub regulation 3(9) of HCC (MSR), 2013, if the existing colleges fail to achieve full compliance of the requirements as specified in the regulation by 31.12.2014 the college may be stopped for taking admission in existing Courses. Further, as per the provision of section 12C (1) of Homoeopathy Central Council (Amendment) Ordinance, 2018, all Homoeopathy Medical Colleges shall seek permission of the Central Government within 01 year from the said commencement in accordance with the provisions specified in the regulations made by the Central Council.

- 2. In order to verify the compliance of the College, Board of Governors to CCH has conducted the inspection of Faculty of Homoeopathic Sciences, Jayoti Vidhyapeeth Woman University, Jaipur, Rajasthan on 09.06.2018 and furnished the report of inspection of CCH to the Ministry for further consideration in the matter of granting permission for the A.Y. 2018-19 and furnished its recommendation as follows: "Recommended for allowing admission in I-BHMS Course for the session 2018-19 with the intake capacity allowed earlier subject to the removal of deficiencies reflected in the report of inspection before 31.12.2018". An opportunity of the hearing was given to the college on 20.07.2018.
- 3. After considering the provisions of section 12C (1) of Homoeopathy Central Council (Amendment) Ordinance, 2018, HCC(MSR) Regulations, 2013, recommendations of the Board of Governors to CCH, policy of the Central Government and report of the designated hearing Committee of this Ministry for granting conditional permission during the session 2018-19, permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to Faculty of Homoeopathic Sciences, Jayoti Vidhyapeeth Woman University, Jaipur, Rajasthan for

continuing admissions in BHMS course with sixty (60) seats for the academic session 2018-19 subject to condition that the college shall fulfill the following requirements by session 2019-20: -

- i. all the Minimum Standard Requirements of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Homoeopathy Central Council (Minimum Standards Requirement of Homoeopathic Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations 2013" by 31st December 2018 to get permission for a period not exceeding five years. Failing which, all the existing colleges, which are not able to achieve full compliance of the requirement as specified in these regulations by the 31st December, 2018, shall be denied permission from academic year 2019-20 onwards and action as envisaged under section 19 of the Act shall be initiated against all such colleges apart from rejection of their applications under sections 12A, which have been under consideration by way of conditional permissions or denials"; and
- ii. all the requirements under the provisions of the HCC Act, 1973 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*.
- 4. The fulfillment of the conditions attached to the permission given above may be made within the specified time period and compliance report should be submitted to the Ministry of AYUSH endorsing a copy to the CCH also. The CCH will verify by means of an inspection that the conditions have been fulfilled and submit a report in this matter to the Ministry of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the session 2019-20.
- 5. The College has to comply with the full requirements of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 by December, 2018 for continuing admissions during the subsequent years. CCH shall verify the compliance well in time for considering the admissions during the Academic Year 2019-20 and furnish the recommendations to the Central Government.
