TYPES OF PROVERS:

Some provers more susceptibile to certain drug groups than the other provers.

Some provers are peculiarly susceptible; it is the peculiarly susceptible in the proving the peculiar, rare and characteristic symptoms of the drug;

Another who are less susceptible they develop symptoms in a small degree. Not all provers will develop all symptoms, some manifest a complete symptom while others will manifest a partial symptom.

The quality of a prover he should be intelligent enough to record the minute alterations from condition of life. these are the subjective symptoms are of the prime value.

Next quality is honesty, he must be very honest to record all alterations as fact. Next quality is he should be in perfect health.

All symptoms must be recorded even those symptoms which are common with many other drugs; because these symptoms possess a certain value in the final selection, we must consider those are the most peculiar and characteristic of the drug-the rare, unusual symptoms, these are the curative symptoms and will guide the selection of the remedy.

One has to caution about making a proving these are:

a complete record of the appearance of all symptoms,

and an analysis of the symptoms, for this all symptoms should be cover in location, sensation, modalities and concomitant if present.
