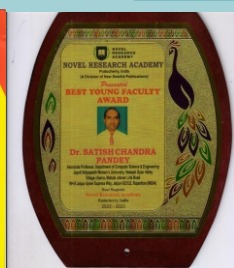

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY AWARENESS MISSION

A one day workshop on intellectual property rights was organized by the entrepreneurship and incubation cell (eic) jayoti vidyapeeth women's university for all faculty members and students.

Government of india has taken initiative of national intellectual property awareness mission (nipam) under which awareness and training would be imparted to students and faculty members on intellectual property rights (iprs). On 23 dec 2022, jvwu jaipur university organized a workshop on "intellectual property rights (iprs)" in collaboration with the office of controller general of patents, designs and trademarks, ministry of education (moe), moe's innovation cell (goi) and kalam program for ip literacy and awareness (kapila) from 1:00 pm at jayoti vidyapeeth women's university. Dr. Jitender sharma, assistant controller of patents & designs was the resource person. His lecture started with the topic, 'what is intellectual property'. Then he discussed on different aspects of intellectual properties like patent, patent rights, trademarks, industrial design, geographical indication, sicil, trade secret, copyright, researcher's rights. He concluded the talk by explaining the rationale of protection and the nature of ipr. ipr are monopoly rights. He emphasized that ipr have to be renewed from time to time for keeping them enforced except in case of copyright and trade secrets. At the end hon'ble advisor and ceo shri vedant garg presented a bouquet and memento to the key speaker. the workshop was highly informative for the students, faculties and research scholars. Faculties from all departments participated in the workshop. This seminar provided valuable awareness and insight on the various aspects of ipr. All the particpates will be awarded with e-certificates also.
