

Due to this system the birth of a daughter is believed as a burden specially in poor family because they have to collect money for their daughter's marriage. Many grooms demand a lot even after the marriage and pressurize the bride and her family to give more money due to which many brides commit suicide. If the demand is not fulfilled then the status of the bride becomes low in the family and many time, they used to do domestic violence. As the disadvantages are in high amount than the advantages of this system so it is considered as a curse of the society. Seeing this, the government in-acted an act that is "The Dowry Prohibition Act", 1961 deals with dowry in India. According to this law giving or taking or advertising of dowry is a punishable offence. But this is not going to come unless we as a society do not stop this practice. We as a society should always encourage to educate the girls, give them the chance to make their own career and to be independent, not to discriminate with them and not to consider girl child as a burden. And we should never encourage the people to take any dowry.
