Sir,

This has reference to Ministry's letter of even No. dated 16.06.2014 wherein a Letter of Permission was issued to the college with respect to the proposal dated 20.04.2013 submitted to the Central Government as citied above with intake capacity of 60 seats in BHMS course for the session 2014-15 and the college administration was asked to develop the requisite infrastructure for II<sup>nd</sup>, III<sup>rd</sup> and IV<sup>th</sup> Professionals well in time as per the CCH norms which will be verified and reported by the CCH at least three months before the start of next professional and accordingly, the permission for taking admissions in subsequent academic session will be issued. Further, vide Ministry's letter of even No. dated 14.07.2015 letter of permission has been issued to the college for continuing 2<sup>nd</sup> BHMS course and for taking admission in 1<sup>st</sup> BHMS Course for the Academic Session 2015-16 with 60 students under section 12A of HCC Act, 1973.

- 2. Further vide letter dated 14.07.2015, the college was granted permission for continuing 1<sup>st</sup> & II<sup>nd</sup> professional BHMS course for the academic session 2015-16 and III<sup>rd</sup> professional BHMS course for the academic session 2016-17.
- 3. In this regard, I am directed to say that after careful consideration of the recommendations of the CCH in terms of the provision of the HCC Act 1973, relevant regulations of the CCH; permission of the Central Government is hereby granted for continuing IV<sup>th</sup> Professional BHMS course and for taking admission in 1<sup>st</sup> BHMS Course for the Academic Session 2017-18 with 60 students by the faculty of Homoeopathic Sciences of the Joyoti Vidyapeeth Women's University, Jaipur, Rajasthan under Section 12A of the HCC Act, 1973

- 4. The college administration will ensure that sufficient qualified teachers and non-teaching staff in the college and requisite staff in the hospital, as per the relevant CCH Regulations are in position before starting IV<sup>th</sup> Professional of BHMS course is made, under intimation to the Central Government and CCH.
- 5. The College has to develop the requisite infrastructure and specific requirements to conduct the compulsory rotatory internship programme of students after IV<sup>th</sup> Professional BHMS course and also to get permission for the session 2018-19.
- 6. The college administration may take up the matter for recognition of the qualification under section 13(I) of the HCC Act, 1973 at that time when the first batch of students admitted against this course appears for the first final professional examination of the said course.
