Agenda 1. To confirm the minutes of the previous meeting of IQAC.

The minutes of the previous IQAC meeting considered and Approved by the IQAC

Agenda 2. To report the action taken on the minutes of the last meeting of IQAC Held on December 21, 2022.

- To Strengthen the Alumni Network, Alumni Local Representatives were elected under student council who have given responsibility to connect with alumni.
- Encouraged participation of students in extension activities, National & International events/competitions for their holistic development
- Faculty members were encouraged with rewarding benefits to attend National/ International conferences, seminars, FDP, and Skill based Training Programmes for effective teaching.
- Scholarship provisions were proposed to attract admissions of existing passing out students to enroll them in PG & PhD Programmes.
- ISO certification and Administrative Audits were conducted successfully, and conduction of academic audit is streamlined for quality improvement.
- New Skill-based and job-oriented PG programmes such as MSc. in Psychology. MSc in Yoga
 & Naturopathy, MSc. Design, PGD were proposed for academic session 20223-24.

All Members expressed their satisfaction with the report and approved of the agenda.

Agenda 3. To identify and strengthen major thrust areas of research across all academic departments.

Discussing key areas of research, IQAC suggested to introduce provisions to support research with an aim to facilitate the development of new interdisciplinary collaborations, support promising research initiatives, and enhance research efforts across all academic departments by identifying capable faculty members with rewarding economic benefits and increasing seed money to support research.

IQAC suggested, to strengthen the research culture, faculty has to identify thrust areas of research with an objective of making research socially relevant; and contributing significantly to the discipline of study. IQAC emphasized collaborative interdisciplinary research by sharing infrastructural facilities, and combined guidance to the students for dissertation/Project work and study in PhD programs.

IQAC also encouraged Industry consultancy and corporate training that enabled faculty to undertake specific assignments for the corporate sector/industry including project/prototype design, testing, and evaluation or even training in new areas of industrial development.

The Director IQAC was asked to submit a report in the next meeting about new initiatives that need to be implemented for strengthening research activities.

Director IQAC presented the overall report on audits such as Administrative Audit, Energy & Environment Audits which have been conducted on December 23, 2023 and Academic Audit which is to be conducted on April 4, 2023 by the peer of external agency.

IQAC expressed their satisfaction with the reports and suggested that further suggestions and proposals may be invited from Faculty Members of the University who have expertise in concerned fields for the successful conduction of such audits.

All Members considered and approved of the agenda.

Agenda 6. To discuss and constitute different committees for NAAC preparation.

IQAC discussed the constitution of various committees consisting of students, scholars and faculty members for effective submission of NAAC (National Assessment and Accreditation Council) data for the second cycle of accreditation.

These committees will present the necessary information and evidence required by NAAC for the accreditation process. IQAC suggested to form committees such as Accreditation Steering Committee, Self-Study Report (SSR) Committee, Data Collection and Documentation Committee, Quality Assurance Committee, Faculty and Student Feedback Committee, Infrastructure and Facilities Committee, Best Practices and Innovations Committee, Documentation and Report Review Committee, Training and Awareness Committee and Timeline and Schedule Committee etc.

IQAC members nominated the potential members for mentioned committees from all departments overall. The Director, IQAC, was asked to submit the details of members at the next meeting.
