Action Taken Report 2020-21

In Pursuance of IQAC meeting held on 18 November 2020 the following actions were taken:

1. As per proposal considered by IQAC, University taken an initiative to form a vertical for nourishment of projects namely, House of Project Nourishment @ JVWU Consists of three major parts i.e. Innovation & Entrepreneurship (IE), Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) and Mentoring to the students and faculty members through a dedicate team which work to all kind of innovative and Research projects
2. Orientation Programme for the newly admitted 1st year students has been organised through virtual mode to inform them about the curriculum, CBCS pattern, examination pattern, facilities, and other co-curricular and extra cocurricular activities of the University.
3. Academic Calendar, Lesson plans and Study materials uploaded on the University developed inhouse LMS "Digital Version 2.0" for smooth conduction of academics during COVID pandemic. Online classes seminars, webinars Guest lectures were conducted to ensure academic and overall development of the students during the pandemic.
4. IQAC designed **160 hours sessions** for research scholars to provide e- lectures, library links and other study tools including face to face online problem-solving session on Google meet so that, Research course work can be started of newly enrolled research scholars in Academic session 2020-21 and whose course work is pending due to lockdown.
5. As IQAC suggested, University organized webinar, seminars & course specific online career counselling sessions etc. for students. Training/Project /Internship of current semester/year completed in a blended mode (online/offline) .by implementing 45 days module 15 days through digital platform and 30 days through physical platform after lockdown.
6. Renovation work of various departments and maintenance work of laboratories were done.
7. COVID Subsidy and Scholarships have been provided to 1429 students.
8. As IQAC suggested, Intellectual Basket of Women National Conference 2020 organized at University virtual base. All the Students and Research Scholars participated virtually.
9. Community Development Activities were conducted online through various activities such as story-writing, essay, public awareness through digital posters, Social work @ Home etc. Students enthusiastically participated in such activities.
10. Faculty members attended workshops, seminars & Faculty Development Programs (FDPs) at National & International level for the enrichment of their professional skills & knowledge. In total 315 conferences and seminars were funded by the University.
