A feedback survey was conducted among key stakeholders like students, faculties, alumni, parents, employers, etc. during the academic session 2022-23. The feedback received by the stakeholders was placed before the members of the IQAC, then IQAC analyzed the feedback report and necessary actions were taken as per the feedback of stakeholders and need of Industry & Society.

Students suggested upgrading the library resources and other sports, cultural and extracurricular activities. Students overall asked for better support services and proper guidance on Innovation and Research activities. The teacher's emphasized on interdisciplinary activities and professional skill-based training for students along with participation of students in outside campus activities/competitions for their essential holistic development.

Alumni suggested for Scholarship & subsidy provisions for alumni students for their Higher Studies from the University. Also, the need to get more opportunities for reunion and easy communication with current students and teachers.

Employers strongly agree with the fact that the curriculum of all programs is employable and skill oriented, fosters leadership and team spirit among the students.
