#### **Achievements of the Year**

The Jayoti Vidyapeeth Women's University, Jaipur has been established and incorporated under the Act 17 of 2008 passed by Rajasthan State Legislature and notified by the Government of Rajasthan through its official Gazette Notification No. F.2 (23) Vidhi /2/2008 dated April 21, 2008. With 7 Faculties, 2 Directorates and more than 7800 students in the regular and distance education mode, the University, in keeping with its traditions and development, has moved from strength to strength. This is reflected in the achievements and signposts established by the University during the past one year of reporting. Brief overviews of the noteworthy achievements of the year 2021-22 are presented here.

### **Infrastructure Additions in the year 2021-22**

In the year 2021-22 some of the structures at the campus were expanded and some new blocks were renovated. Jayoti Vidyapeeth Women's University worked in close coordination with the University officials to design plans for the building in keeping with the needs of the University and also the stipulations lay down by the Statutory Bodies. Each University Official was deeply involved in the developmental activities of the University. The University's Board of Management was at the helm of affairs giving directions and taking stock of developments every step of the way.

The JVWU has world class facilities with seminar rooms, ICT enabled classrooms, well equipped laboratories, and digital library. In the year 2021-22, the existing computer labs are enriched with new computers. The libraries were enriched with latest editions of several books which inculcated the expenditure of approximately 30 lakhs. Besides this approximately funds of Rs. 1.5 crore were utilized for the purchase of equipment, furniture, and fixtures during the year 2021-22.

All the administrative blocks, academic blocks, classrooms, staff rooms, lobbies, computer labs, laboratories and other areas are equipped with CCTV cameras to ensure the In the year 2021-22 University renovated some blocks, fountain area, parking area, Mess Area, and other areas. Besides this, all the academic, administrative and hostels blocks are checked for infrastructure maintenance and the repairing work was accordingly done.

Bakery Pilot Plant has been renovated and restarted on 21.12.2021. Now the University's bakery products prepared by Food Science students are available to all students and staff members once again.


### ☐ Independence Day Celebration

### **Workshop on Soil Testing**








☐ **JV Mantra Day:** Jayoti Vidyapeeth Women's University celebrated JV Mantra Day on 21<sup>st</sup> of every month.

The University will continue to contribute to the prevention of COVID-19 through the health services provided by "Suryansh Arogyashala" and team of medical staff of the University.



# Online Feedback


