ACHIEVEMENTS OF THE YEAR

The Jayoti Vidyapeeth Women's University, Jaipur has been established and incorporated under the Act 17 of 2008 passed by Rajasthan State Legislature and notified by the Government of Rajasthan through its official Gazette Notification No. F.2 (23) Vidhi /2/2008 dated April 21, 2008. With 7 Faculties, 2 Directorates and more than 8000 students in the regular and distance education mode, the University, in keeping with its traditions and development, has moved from strength to strength. This is reflected in the achievements and signposts established by the University during the past one year of reporting. Brief overviews of the noteworthy achievements of the year 2020-2021 are presented here.

Contribution during Lockdown COVID 19

University is continuously serving the community during this pandemic by all means and left no stone unturned for community development in its truest sense.

Summary of University's selfless contribution during COVID-19 for the community are as follows:

1. Established 500 bedded Quarantine Centre

1.1 Coordinating Officer appointed by Government of Rajasthan

1.2 Provided Homoeopathic Medicine Arsenic Album 30 as a Immunity Booster to 638 Quarantine patients and 43 Quarantine Centre Health Workers

2. Distributed Arsenic Album and Ayurvedic Medicine to 2504 University girl students as Immunity Booster

3. Distributed Arsenic Album and Ayurvedic Medicine to 373 University staff

4. Distributed Arsenic Album to 603 residents of University adopted villages.

5. Distributed Arsenic Album 30 to approximately 5000 residents of villages (Dudu division) with the Government Department. After its success Government declared the "Khajpura Model" due to Immunity boosting and breaking the Corona Chain and 4 | P a g e

its spread. Govt repeat the model to 1010 residents of the nearby village Boraj to break the Corona Chain and its spread.

6. Donation of 11,00,000/- (Eleven Lakh Rupees) and food packets to Relief Fund of Government of Rajasthan.

7. Two research papers published on COVID 19 Clinical Management sent to AYUSH ministry for further approval

Dr. Garg recommended the same source of Hydroxychloroquine (HCQ) in Clinical Management of Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) of Modern medicine with Ayurveda or Homoeopathy. In Ayurveda medicine namely Cinchona bark and in Homoeopathy Chininum Sulp are formed from same source of Hydroxychloroquine (HCQ).

7.2 Paper Acceptance ID: I0150687 Title: "Identification of Ayurveda & amp; Homeopathic Medicine for Clinical Management of Covid-19 need Clinical Trial" to be published on International Journal of Scientific & Engineering Research, Volume 20, Issue 6, June-2020 ISSN 2229-5518. Dr. Garg mentioned that the modern medicine Remedesevir is formed from Rhodolia Rosea (root part). Their powder form may be used to formation of Ayurvedic Medicine and their tritulation form may be used in the formation of Homoeopathic medicine. In present scenario need to the preparation of both medicines and clinical trial because in hilly areas these root part powder used as herbal medicine against viral infection.

According to Dr.Garg same source of medicinal plant "RHODOLIA ROSEA" (root part) can be applicable for Homoeopathic Approaches. We can isolate efficient compound according to

Homeopathic Protocols and can apply for covid-19 patients. It will be more effective as an individual or Integrative form of research.

Rhodiola Rosea has shown marked anti oxidative, adaptogenic and antifatigue effect in the experimental study, this effect can be used to increase the immunity of the patient, can eventually be proved effective in the treatment of Covid-19. It will be more effective as an individual or Integrative form of research.

On the basis of same mode of antiviral activity. Remdesivir act directly on virus to stop multiplication & Rhodiola rosea act naturally enhance immunity against virus.






2. International Day of Yoga










8. Jyoti Sangh 2021 Elections

Everyone followed the Corona guidelines on this occasion. Social distancing was also followed along with masks.






2. Virtual elections for Class Representatives


