ID AYU0348) or intake capacity of 54 seats [instead of 60 seats] in UG (BAMS) course, for the academic session 2023-24 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020-regarding.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021.

- Further, to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, Hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely Faculty of Ayurvedic Science, Jyoti Vidyapeeth Women's University, Vedant Gyan Valley, Jharna, Mahla-Jobner Link Road Jaipur-303122, Rajasthan (Inst. ID AYU0348), inspection of your College was conducted on 03.08.2023 & 04.08.2023 on Hybrid mode as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and rating Board, NCISM to process the Conditional Permission with 60 seats, in UG BAMS Course for the academic session 2023-24 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder.
- 2. Further, in view of above, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulation namely, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016 and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under. On examining the case in light of above notified and approved criteria and on perusal of the visitation report, it was observed that the college was not fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria due to following shortcomings: -

2. Observation by Visitors

- a. During visitation it has been observed that the hospital is also running two allopathic medicine OPDs which includes Gynaecology and obstetrics and dental science.
- b. Physical attendance register of teaching, non-teaching and hospital staff were not available in the institute.
- 3. In view of above, the assessment report was placed in the 57nd Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) on 05.09.2023. On careful examination of the assessment report, considering the deficiencies observed therein as mentioned above the college was given an opportunity of virtual hearing vide the MARBISM letter (Hearing notice) of even no. dated 06.09.2023 to appear on 13.09.2023 before the designated Hearing Committee to present their case and to show cause as to why not the conditional permission to your with 60 seats, in UG BAMS Course for the academic session 2023-24 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020. The applicant college was directed to make written submission in respect of the case and produce all relevant valid documents/records/proof to substantiate the claims against all the deficiencies/shortcomings as indicated above. The representatives of the college submitted written submissions dated 11.09.2023 vide letter no. UAO/JPR/2023/111 against the deficiencies conveyed to them.
- 4. Whereas, the college through its representative, Dr. Shikha Sharma, Principal, Dr. Heema, Registrar and Dr. Vedant Garg., Chairman, appeared before the Hearing Committee on 13.09.2023 and made their submission virtually as well as written submission against the shortcomings communicated to the college. The shortcomings communicated to the college, submission made by the representatives of the Ayurveda college and observations made by the Hearing Committee are as under:-

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- 5. The observation of hearing committee based on the submission made by the college representatives during hearing and assessment report of the NCISM have been carefully re-examined in terms of Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016" and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2022 and relevant regulations thereunder, and once again as per the direction of President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM), the recommendation of Hearing Committee was placed in the 58th Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) on 14.09.2023.
- 6. In view of the above, the observation of Hearing Committee based on the submission made by the college representatives during hearing and assessment report have been carefully examined in terms of concerned Regulation and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder, and the board decided that the college is not fulfilling the criteria for issuance of Conditional Permission for 60 seats, in UG (BAMS) Course under section 28 of NCISM Act 2020 for the Academic Session 2023-24, but the Board decided to issue Conditional Permission as per the approved Seat Reduction Policy in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act 2020 for failing to maintain the minimum essential standards for the Academic year 2023-24, wherein it is mentioned that:
 - a. "For deficiency of **every one teacher**, seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by 10% of total intake capacity."

Accordingly as per Schedule–V Note (iii) of MSR 2016 the deficiency of teacher for up to sixty intake capacity shall not exceed more than ten percent of total requirement. As per the Hearing Committee observation and approval of Minutes in the **58th Board meeting** of MARBISM, college is having only **26** total eligible Teaching faculties.

There is deficiency of 01 teacher for issuance of Conditional Permission for academic session 2023-24 as per Schedule–V Note (iii) of MSR 2016. <u>Therefore, in accordance of seat Reduction Policy 2023-2024, for deficiency of one teachers, seat reduction in the intake capacity shall be considered by reducing the intake strength by 10% of total intake capacity.</u>

- Hence, after applying the seat reduction policy 2023-24 under section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act 2020, the college is fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for issuance of Conditional Permission with 54 seats [instead of 60 seats] in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2023-24 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020.
- 8. Therefore, in view of shortcomings and deficiencies mentioned as above, Conditional Permission is issued to Faculty of Ayurvedic Science, Jyoti Vidyapeeth Women's University, Vedant Gyan Valley, Jharna, Mahla-Jobner Link Road Jaipur-303122, Rajasthan (Inst. ID AYU0348) with 54 seats [instead of 60 seats] in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2023-24 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder, subject to the following conditions:-
 - (i) It is further informed that 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 54 seats [instead of 60 seats] in UG (BAMS) course. The counseling for seats under all India quotas shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder
- 9. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
- 10. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- 11. Further, as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or subsequent year.
- 12. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2023 and send a compliance report to get permission for the academic session 2024-25:
 - (i) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for undergraduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
 - (ii) All the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda);

- (iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto; and
- 13. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2024-25.
