**Conclusion**

A survey study was conducted over a period of one and half year from April 2016 to October 2017. Skin OPD, from the Department of Dermatology, Maheshwari Hospital Badli. During the study, the total no. of patients examined was 300. Out of 300 patients of dermatomycosis, 150 cases of dermatophytosis (50%), 100 cases of pityriasis versicolor (33.3%) and 50 cases of Candidiasis (16.6%). Among the 150 suspected patient with clinical symptoms of dermatophytosis, 130 (86%) samples were found positive KOH by direct microscopy examination and 90 (60%) were confirmed in culture.

In the present study mixture of turmeric + ginger oil and Pine + Peppermint oil were used. The result of the present work on antifungal activity of mixture of oil against *T. mentagrophytes*, *T. rubrum*, *T. tonsurans* & *M. audouinii* was found to be highest than single oils & reference drugs. Inhibition zone of mixture of oils (turmeric + ginger) was found greater than inhibition zone of turmeric and ginger oil alone. Another mixture of oils (pine & peppermint) oils was screened for the antifungal activity against human pathogenic fungi in vitro.
