



At the outset, the convener welcomes all the members present in the meeting.

Agenda 1. To confirm the last meeting minutes of Board of Studies.

The minutes from the last BOS meeting were unanimously confirmed by the members.

Agenda 2. To discuss and revise Syllabus of all UG and PG level programs under Faculty of Physiotherapy and Diagnostics

The Members of the Board of Studies reviewed and provided their insight the syllabus of all the program of the faculty of Physiotherapy and Diagnostics.

- Syllabus for optometry should be revised on the basis of guidelines by Ministry of Health & welfare. Credits assigned to various courses must also be in tune of the credit hours as suggested by the ministry for optometry.
- Program Outcome, Program Specific Outcome should be mentioned for all the programs for which the BOS concluded that these already in places digitally on e-portal. A discussion was also done on the holistic perspective/approach for all the programme and BOS concluded that it is very well in place.
- The BOS was of the opinion that the uniformity in practical content mentioned within different units in a course must be maintained for MLT for which the members were agreed.
- Proper Coding of courses should be mentioned in the syllabus for MLT based on the specialization of the course. BOS also agreed upon the removal of repeated content from the MLT syllabus. The BOS agreed and approved the syllabus

Agenda 3. To discuss planning to offer new specializations in post-graduation programs & PG diploma level.

The Board of Studies (BOS) discussed the introduction of new specializations for post-graduate programs and PG diploma courses to enhance academic offerings and align with industry trends.

1. MPT Program (Master of Physiotherapy)

- The BOS proposed the addition of the following new specializations:
 - Sports Physiotherapy
 - Cardio Physiotherapy
 - Dual Specialization (Ortho/Neuro/Sports/Cardio/Musculoskeletal)

These specializations are expected to meet the growing demand for expertise in sports rehabilitation and cardiovascular therapy.

All members of the BOS agreed unanimously to introduce these new specializations in the MPT program.

2. PG Diploma Programs

It was noted that additional specializations at the PG diploma level would be explored further in future meetings to align with emerging healthcare and industry needs.

The new Dual specializations in MPT will be introduced from the next academic session. Detailed course structures and syllabuses will be prepared for review in the next BOS meeting.

The BOS acknowledged the importance of expanding academic specializations to keep up with market demand and industry relevance. The addition of Sports and Cardio Physiotherapy specializations was approved unanimously from the current session.

Agenda 4 To strengthen clinical and industrial exposure for Pre final & Final Year students at UG & PG level.

The Board of Studies (BOS) discussed the importance of clinical and industrial exposure in enhancing the practical skills and employability of students across both undergraduate (UG) and postgraduate (PG) programs.

It was agreed that students should undergo 45 days of clinical exposure during the annual break after the first year, which will continue in each consecutive year.

The Pre- Final and final year clinical exposure will involve intensive, hands-on experience in clinical settings (University Hospital) or during their internship to prepare students for professional challenges.

All members unanimously agreed to implement the clinical exposure schedule across all relevant UG and PG programs.

Agenda 5. To discuss Ethics Research and Publication for strengthening research culture at UG, PG level in view of the vision and mission of the university.


The members discussed research & publication ethics; the members were of the opinion that FDPs need to be held at least every quarter in a year. Publications should be linked to the appraisal of the faculty members, which is already in place. One paper Publication should be necessary for the pre-final and final year students in the UGC care journals. All members of the BOS concluded that most of these recommendations are already in place only frequency of FDP is to be increased

Agenda 6. To discuss and revise rules & regulations of Internal and External examinations as per UGC norms.


All members agreed that Departments already follows all the rules and regulations for Internal & external examinations as per UGC norms.
