7.1. Measures initiated by the Institution for the promotion of gender equity.

Inclusive Curriculum:

A) Safety and security:

Jayoti Vidyapeeth Women's University is committed to providing a safe and secure environment for our students. To ensure their safety, we have implemented strict measures such as mobile prohibition, high-security protocols, full-time CCTV surveillance, and 24x7 security at all checkpoints.

High Security and Safety for Girls:

We take the safety of our female students very seriously and have implemented several measures to ensure their security. We have deployed trained security personnel at all entry and exit points, who conduct thorough security checks to ensure that no unauthorized individuals enter the premises. We also have a dedicated helpline number for female students to report any safety concerns or incidents of harassment.

Mobile Prohibition:

In order to prevent incidents of harassment, stalking, and cyberbullying, we have enforced a strict mobile prohibition policy for our students as well as for external members or visitors etc. All students are required to deposit their phones at the designated area or keep their phones in mobile lockers before entering the premises or Hostel premises. This helps to prevent unauthorized access to sensitive information and ensures that students are not distracted during class time.

Full-Time CCTV Surveillance:

To ensure complete safety and security, we have installed CCTV cameras at all key locations within the campus. These cameras are monitored by trained security personnel round-the-clock, ensuring that any suspicious activity is immediately detected and reported. The footage is also regularly reviewed for any potential safety risks or incidents.

24x7 Security at all Checkpoints:

Our institution has a strong and reliable security infrastructure in place, with security personnel stationed at all checkpoints round-the-clock. Our security personnel are equipped with the necessary training and tools to handle any potential safety issues that may arise. In addition, we conduct regular safety drills and trainings to ensure that our personnel are always prepared to handle any situation.

Authorized Communication:

University understand the importance of communication between parents and students. To ensure that our students have access to a secure and authorized communication facility, we have implemented a system of landline phones that only allow calls to be made to pre-verified mobile numbers authorized and registered by their parents. This system is designed to provide an additional layer of security and peace of mind to parents, knowing that their daughters can only make calls to authorized numbers. It also ensures that our students are not exposed to unwanted calls or communication from unknown sources, which can be a potential safety concern.

This system of authorized communication facilities through landline phones not only provides a secure way for parents and students to stay in touch but also helps to promote responsible phone usage among students. By limiting calls to authorized numbers, students are encouraged to use their phones only when necessary and to focus on their studies during class time.

B) Counselling Centres:

University has established dedicated centralized Department Communication Centres (CC) that definitely works for students' welfare. Along with this, University has Set up counselling centres in hostels for girl students to provide emotional support, mental health services, and overall well-being resources. These Counselling centres are monitored by each Warden of particular hostel which offer a safe comfortable and confidential space for students to discuss their concerns and receive guidance & support from trained professionals.

Here are some key considerations for establishing counselling centres in hostels for girls' students:

1. Supprotive & Caring Staff:

Dealing with various psychological and emotional issues faced by students and to address issues specific to young women, such as self-esteem, body image, relationship challenges, and academic stress.

2. Confidentiality:

3. Wide-ranging Services:

University Provides a range of services, including individual counselling, workshops, and educational sessions on mental health, health & wellbeing, stress management etc.

4. Awareness Campaigns:

Organize awareness campaigns to reduce the stigma surrounding mental health issues. This can include workshops, seminars, and informational materials etc.

5. Cultural Sensitivity:

Consider the cultural backgrounds of the students and provide counsellors who are sensitive to these differences. Cultural competence is crucial for effective counselling.

6. Regular Interaction, Feedback & Evaluations:

University Continuously assess the effectiveness of the counselling centre through frequent interaction with students, feedback mechanism, and monitoring of the students' physical & mental health status by the team of experts.

8. Online Support:

In addition to in-person Counselling, consider offering online or virtual Counselling services for students if required.

C) Common Rooms:

University provides students Common rooms in university academic blocks as well as in Hostel premises that can serve a variety of purposes for female students. Common rooms serve as quiet study spaces where female students can concentrate on their academic work individually or in groups. comfortable seating, study tables, and access to power outlets provided to the students in common rooms to create an environment conducive to learning. students often use these common rooms for group activities, or to conduct meetings for academic or interest-based clubs, societies, or student organizations. This fosters leadership skills and involvement in extracurricular activities.

By maximizing the potential of common rooms, university cater to the diverse needs of female students, fostering a sense of belonging, empowerment, and holistic development. Regular feedback from students also helps tailor the usage of these spaces to their evolving needs and preferences.

D) Anti Sexual Harassment Cell:

Anti Sexual Harassment Cell is also playing an active role to ensure safety of the students. It often organizes various events on awareness issues. Students have direct access to the cell of Anti Sexual Harassment for registered their any written or verbal/oral compliant.

E) Anti-Ragging Committee:

Anti-Ragging Committee of university ensures compliance with the provisions of UGC Regulations as well as the provisions of any law for the time being in force concerning ragging; and, to monitor and oversee the performance of the Anti-Ragging Squad in prevention of ragging in the institution.
