Extension Activities through Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA)

The University is working in the direction of Community Development since its inception 2008 through various programs under "Community Development Activities & University Mission Courses" and "Rural Community Development Projects" under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan.

During the Academic Session 2022-23, the University conducted many activities within the campus as well as off-campus related to Education, Medical, Agriculture fields along with various public awareness programmes. The University is providing medical facilities to the community through its teaching hospitals. The University has three hospitals, 6 Village Development Centers, 8 PHCs & the 5 adopted villages (Jharna, Devia, Keshringhpura, Kapilyawas and Kotjewar) through MHRD rural development project of UBA.

Some of the major activities conducted throughout the year are highlighted as under:

Awareness on World Environment Day 5 June 2023:

Jayoti Vidyapeeth Women's University, Jaipur participated in an event on 5th June 2023 to celebrate World Environment Day and raise awareness about environmental issues and promote positive action for the protection and conservation of our planet. Rajasthan Environment & Conservation Centre organized World Environment Day Summit and a remarkable exhibition in collaboration with several universities to mark this special day. This artistic exhibition of the event aimed to celebrate the beauty of nature and raise awareness about environmental conservation through the lens of art.

Jayoti Vidyapeeth Women's University Jaipur's students of Fine arts and Journalism participated in paintings and Photography exhibition where they exhibit collection of paintings with each artwork conveying a powerful environmental message.

The Journalism students successfully showcased the power of visual storytelling in highlighting environmental issues. Environmental Education Awareness Program on 23 May, 2023:

Jayoti Vaidyapeeth Women's University, Jaipur conducted Community development Activities under Ummat Bharat Abhiyan at Iharna Village where students along with their mentor teachers conducted Environmental Education Awareness Program in adopted villages to encourage people to keep water for the animals and birds in summer season. They also kept pots filled with water at different places for birds and animals and also distributed birdhouses made from waste materials to the people and advised them to hang these houses in their houses so that birds can make their nests or find a safe place to live during summer season.





Waste Management & Cleanliness Drive 18-19 May, 2023:

University conducted two days Waste Management & Cleanliness Drive on 18-19 May, 2023. Under this students and staff members learnt to prepare paper from the waste paper and how to handle paper making machine. From the waste papers, they prepared Handmade Paper Sheets and converted them to Paper bags, file folders and beautiful bird houses. These two-day activities started from 18th May where students participated in making handmade paper sheets, paper bags and bird houses from waste material/waste. These bird houses were hanged on the trees all over the campus of the University, so that birds could take shelter in these houses.

In a significant stride towards promoting sustainability and combating paper waste, University has developed a groundbreaking recycling process Under University Startup Centre- Purnar Janam that converts paper waste into high-quality paper. This technique marks a remarkable achievement in the field of recycling. By harnessing the potential of paper waste, we can significantly reduce our ecological footprint while simultaneously meeting our paper needs.



International Day of Yoga (19.6.2023-21.6.2023):

Jyoti Vidyapeeth Women's University organized a weeklong celebration for International Yoga Day starting from 19.6.2023. "Sarvangin Samridhi Yoga" was organized under the joint collaboration of Jyoti Vidyapeeth Women's University Jaipur & Union Football Club at Ramniwas Bagh Jaipur. This event was attended by more than 1000 participants. In this yoga program, a one-hour yoga session was organized under the direction of the famous yoga guru of Rajasthan Shri Dhukaram ji. Renowned personalities of the city attended this event along with the University Management.

Free Medical camp at Village- Village- Mahla, Jaipur on 17 March 2023

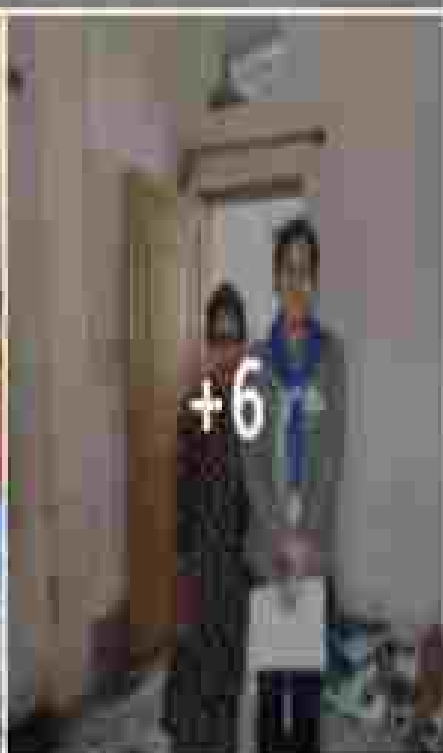

The Free Health Camp aimed to provide accessible and affordable health services to the community, with a focus on preventative care and early detection of potential health issues. This camp was open to individuals of all ages and offered a range of services, including blood pressure and blood tests, and consultations with doctors. Participants were also provided with information on healthy living and disease prevention. Approx 200 individuals attended the camp, with a roughly equal distribution of men and women. The free health check-up camp was a success in providing accessible and affordable health services to the community. The high attendance and positive feedback from participants indicate a strong need for such events in the area.

During the camp Rajasthan University's student leader Shri Nirmal Choudhary thanked Jayoti Vidyapeeth Women's University for organizing free Health Care Camp and said such camps should continue to be held regularly to ensure that community members have ongoing access to preventative health services. In this free medical consultation camp, Ophthalmologist, Ear, Nose, Throat Specialist, Gynaecologist, Homoeopathy Specialist, Ayurveda Specialist, Yoga & Naturopathy Specialist, Physiotherapist (Dr. Mitunakshi, Dr. Sonam, Dr. Sonali, Dr. Mukta, Dr. Manoj Gaur, Dr. Trivani, Dr. Pkta) as well as medical students provided their services and all tests (blood group, blood pressure, sugar) were provided free of cost. The people who attended said that they were benefited by the facilities provided in the free medical consultation camp. Medical Camp is an opportunity for the Social Work students to have a better experience of community life & improve their professional skills by organizing need-based programmes & awareness campaigns with the support and collaboration of local people. It also provides ample opportunity for students to learn the importance of adjustment & coordination in life.

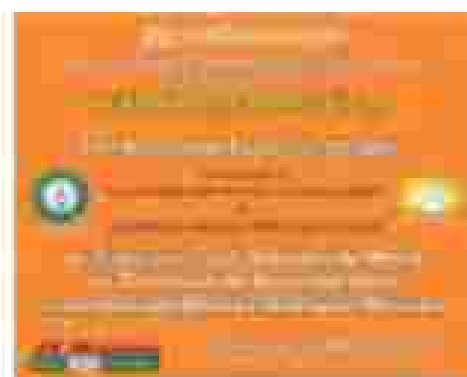

4. With the establishment of Bank, Post Office, Hospitals, Community Radio Station & other basic amenities for general public marked for upliftment of nearby community.

A groups of Women from each adopted villages provide the training by Teacher and students mentors for production of products and items as specified for particular villages under University Startup recognized by Startup India namely "MahilaSamudhGramodhyog" & "Nee Rasoi" by using their traditional skills and methods and utilize their free time. Each adopted Villages selected to produce minimum 1 homemade product and 1 handicraft or handmade items.

- a) Village Jharain for Papad Badi and Gaudhumbhatriniya
- b) Village Kachinisingipura for Vinegar and Handmade items
- c) Village Kapadiyamas for Sauce / Chutney & for Compost Insect Repellent
- d) Village Kotejwar for Murabba Jam & Blue Pottery Terra-cotta
- e) Village Devia for pickles and khadi items.

5. Employment Generation: Implemented reservation policy in recruitment of all the posts since past 12 years.

- 60% posts are reserved for the reserved categories residing within 20 Kms of radius of University surrounding villages –
- 30% posts are reserved for Women, having Domicile in Rajasthan.

6. Prevent Dropout Ratio: To encourage local girl's aspirants for higher education and prevent dropouts.

University is having 5 Village Development Centres (VDCs), 2 Private Health Centres (PHCs) and Integrated Facility Centre (IFC) located at Village - Mahala and acts as a referral hospital for its VDCs and PHCs.

We strongly recommend that community development activity should be a compulsory part of curriculum which is purely based on physical implementation of related curriculum of the discipline for community development. It is also recommended that minimum 30-40 hours per session should be allotted to student and evaluation on the basis of Grading system which should be mentioned on marksheet and also provide a separate certificate mentioning total number of hours dedicated to community development.
